

Is DUI Expungement Possible In Pennsylvania?



In most cases, getting your record expunged can be extremely difficult. If you are on your first DUI charge, you may qualify for the Accelerated Rehabilitative Disposition, or ARD. Those who go through this program may be eligible for expungement 10 years after their conviction, given their driving privileges were not suspended for another reason during that time.

If you are not eligible for ARD, it can seem close to impossible to get a DUI stricken from your record. You must meet one of these three qualifications:

1



You are at least 70 years old and have been free of arrest or prosecution for 10 years since the completion of probation supervision.

2



You have been deceased for at least three years.

3



You petition the court for the expungement of a “summary offense” and have been free of arrest or prosecution for five years following the conviction for the prior offense.
